

How to use this tool

WHAT IS THIS TOOL?: This tool is a guided activity to support LIAs with building a team to help develop a Theory of Change and pilot a new implementation strategy.

HOW TO USE IT: This tool can be used as a job aid or resource for LIAs. An Implementation Specialist and use it to facilitate an activity with an LIA and work with them to answer the prompts for each section or the LIA can complete the worksheet on their own and use it to document their planning process.

CONSIDERATIONS: Implementation Specialist may want to consider adapting the tool for the needs of their LIA.
